

- Member identity. Who is the community for, what is the profile of the most active members.





Computational Framework - September 2021

- Enabling Delft-FEWS to run in non-operational modes, it can run tasks such as batch running, and the comparison of model runs.
- One of the key concepts is the Delft-FEWS standalone links to the archive in the similar way as the OC connects to the database.

Preferred system architecture for modelling studies:




SEPA cyber attack 'displayed significant stealth and malicious sophistication' – Learnings for Scotland's public sector say audits

苗 27 October 2021

The December 2020 cyber-attack against the Scottish Environment Protection Agency (SEPA) 'displayed significant stealth and malicious sophistication' according to a series of independent audits published today (27 October 2021) by Scotland's environmental watchdog.

- SEPA cyber-attack 'likely by international serious organised criminals'.
- Attack 'displayed significant stealth and malicious sophistication with a secondary and deliberate attempt to compromise SEPA systems as the team endeavoured to recover and restore back-ups'.
- SEPA did not respond to ransom request and was clear that it would not use public finance to pay serious and organised criminals.
- SBRC determined SEPA's cyber maturity assessment as high and that sophisticated defence and detection mechanisms were implemented and operating correctly prior to the incident.
- SBRC notes 'no implementation regime can be 100% secure'


